

Call for Applications: Residency at HAU Hebbel am Ufer's Houseclub April/May 2018

HAU Hebbel am Ufer presents current artistic positions at the intersection of theatre, dance, and performance. Music, the visual arts, and discursive events are further key components of the program. Without relying on a permanent ensemble, HAU develops and stages international co-productions, festivals, and projects realized in tandem with Berlin's and the (inter)national theatre and dance scene.

As part of the outreach program of HAU Hebbel am Ufer, regular workshops for young people have been taking place at the Houseclub since 2011. The Houseclub is tailored to the interests of high school students. It seeks to engage in a dialog and exchange with them through contemporary theatre and dance projects. On a regular basis, HAU Hebbel am Ufer invites artists to develop ideas together with these young actors and express them artistically. Houseclub brings together artists and high school students and provides the many spatial possibilities that come with a studio and a stage.

Preconditions:

All artists who represent the genres performance, theatre, dance, or music and live predominantly in Germany are eligible to apply for the residency program. If accepted, they will be able to use the frame of the Houseclub to explore artistic questions together with students of Hector-Peterson high school and present the results in a shared public performance. Applicants should have a pronounced interest in questions surrounding urban spaces and the changing social cityscape, and should further be sensitive to the collaboration with teenagers ranging from age 13 to 16. Artists are required to be present during the two months of their residency. Using the studio and training facilities between workshop phases is actively encouraged.

HAU Hebbel am Ufer Stipend:

HAU Hebbel am Ufer offers a two-months residency at its Houseclub from April to May 2018. The program entails the free use of the facilities as well as a financial contribution to the production that amounts to 4.000,- Euro, which can be used to develop the artistic project. In addition to offering a direct connection to HAU Hebbel am Ufer's infrastructure, the residency also includes the repatriation of material and technical expenses of 2000,- Euro total for up to two presentations.
