# **Artistic Manoeuvres for the Digital Present**Online Hackathon and Residency Programme as Digital Lab

We really hadn't expected 2020 to be like this. If this year has shown us anything, it is that it's more important than ever to experiment, to bring different ways of thinking together, to learn together and to create.

HAU Hebbel am Ufer, Berlin's international production house for theatre, dance, performance, music, visual arts and theory, would like to offer a platform for this. Effective immediately, our online programme, the digital stage HAU4, will supplement the "analogue" performance venues HAU1, HAU2 and HAU3 as an equal venue.

## **Digital Lab**

Together with you and in cooperation with **Christiane Hütter** and the collective **dgtl fmnsm**, we would like to explore the options of what the present and future of a theatre composed of multiple spaces – digital, analogue and hybrid – can look like.

What forms of digital "liveness" can we create? How can we get young people excited about theatre that have never gone to a theatre before? How can we subvert commercially oriented platforms? What online tools can be further developed in the sense of self-determined work in order to avoid reproducing old barriers such as systemic racism, sexism and ableism as a result of technology-related mechanisms of exclusion? How can we use technology in order to develop new aesthetics and make performative formats more accessible?

## Invitation to the Hackathon

We warmly invite you to take part in an online hackathon over the course of 2.5 days where utopias for the theatre of the future will be developed.

## What will actually happen?

Over the course of 2.5 days, ideas for projects or initial prototypes will be created within new interdisciplinary teams. At the end, a jury will decide together with all of the participants, which projects will continue to be developed. Three teams will each receive a paid three-week research residency at HAU Hebbel am Ufer (October / November / December 2020) in order to further develop their projects. At the end, there will be a joint closing event.
